





## **A CONFEDERACY OF DUNCES**

This 1981 Pulitzer Prize winning novel is set in New Orleans with a wild cast of characters including protagonist Ignatius J. Reilly and his mother; Miss Trixie, the octogenarian assistant accountant at Levi Pants; inept, wan Patrolman Mancuso; Darlene, the Bourbon Street stripper with a penchant for poultry; and Jones, in space-age dark glasses. The novel serves as an outlandish but believable tribute to a city defined by its parade of eccentric denizens. The novel is considered a comic masterpiece.


