

***** NOTICE TO OLD BRIDGE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS *****

**CONSTRUCTION TO TAKE PLACE ON TEXAS ROAD DUE TO OBMUA
CROSSROADS REGIONAL SEWER WORK PERFORMED BY
NORTHEAST REMSCO CONSTRUCTION, INC.**

Northeast Remsco Construction was contracted by the Old Bridge Municipal Utilities Authority (OBMUA) to install new sewers on Texas Road. The work on Texas Road will consist of open cut installation methods along a section of Texas Road located between Route 9 and Marlboro Road.

The work along Texas Road is scheduled to commence the week of **APRIL 14** and is expected to take approximately five (5) weeks. **ON WEEKDAYS DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PERIOD, TEXAS ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC BETWEEN ROUTE 9 AND MARLBORO ROAD.** (Texas Road will be open to vehicular traffic on weekends.)

ALL VEHICULAR TRAFFIC WILL BE DETOURED AROUND THE ROAD CLOSURE VIA ROUTE 9 AND MARLBORO ROAD. Detour signage will be installed to direct traffic along the detour route. The entrance to CVS Plaza located along Texas Road will remain accessible at all times during construction. The Old Bridge Police Department will be present for traffic control during initial construction operations and as required during the course of construction.
