HORNIK TO DEDICATE AMBULANCE

Morganville First Aid Squad will Host Open House to Celebrate

MARLBORO TOWNSHIP, NEW JERSEY (September 5, 2012) – The Morganville First Aid and Rescue Squad will be answering emergency calls in a new ambulance. Marlboro Mayor Jonathan Hornik will dedicate the ambulance at 1:00pm on September 8, 2012. The dedication will take place in conjunction with the Squad's Annual Open House.

“Marlboro Township is lucky to have not one, but two, First Aid Squads that are made up entirely of volunteers, on call 24/7,” Hornik stated. “While we hope we never need their services, they provide a critical resource when our residents call for help. I am honored that they asked me to dedicate their new ambulance.”

The new ambulance replaces a model that was built in 1988. The Squad had been battling repairs and maintenance with the old rig which necessitated the upgrade. “The new vehicle is a 2010 demo model and it was purchased at a greatly reduced price compared to other models”, said Alan Miller, spokesman for Morganville First Aid and Rescue Squad. He added that a 2012 model “was quoted at \$20,000 more.” 2010 is the last model year that will use diesel fuel, which, according to Miller, can save as much as \$3,600 per year in fuel costs.

“We are very thankful that we have such great squads in Marlboro Township to protect our residents,” Council President Jeff Cantor added. “Everyone in town is pleased with the quality of care that they provide, and we are lucky to have them.”

Morganville First Aid and Rescue Squad's Open House will be held from noon to 4pm. The open house will include a \$1 car wash, a raffle to win a 50" television and a gift basket auction. The new ambulance will be available for visitors to explore and members of the squad will be on hand to answer questions.
