Ted Ernst reported that the safety issue at the recreation center during summer camp hours was discussed with the police department and the police will provide coverage during camp drop-off and pick-up times. He stated that the summer concert dates have been set, the first concert to be held on July 9th which will include a fireworks display, the Blues and Barbecue will be held during the July 29/30 weekend, the second concert will be on August 6th and Marlboro Day is scheduled for September 9th, rain date, September 17th

Pool update by Bob Shapiro: There will be a new snack bar vendor, the Bob Olaha Grill at the Marlboro Swim Club. Programs for active adults will start at the pool this summer, with Pickle Ball being one of the activities planned. Membership is still open for the Swim Club.

Denise Barry reported that brochures for the summer programs for seniors is in the works, that we will be again having classes at the Monmouth Worship Center. We need a volunteer to continue Phyllis Schnall's role as communications representative working with local newspapers disseminating promotional materials to residents. Denise reported that she tried to set up an IT program for seniors but because there is no internet access at the senior center it is not possible. Trips and special events programs

have not been well attended and the thinking is to cut back on the offers.

Diane Tracy reported that there are wonderful services offered by the Office on Aging and advised that in addition to the Freehold office, there is a satellite office in Neptune that provides many of the same services, such as passport application and processing.
