Proposed Tree Park

The State has begun restoring the former Marlboro Psychiatric property. The property will be preserved as a park. Plans will be revisited at the time the state transfers' ownership to Marlboro Township which is estimated near year end of 2014.

Open items from the October meeting

- **Five Year Forestry Plan** –. The committee is on track for the first half of the year to meet our goals.
- **Tree City USA** – The accomplishment report will be completed by February 15, 2014 by Chairperson, Jeff Weiss.
- **Arbor Day 2014** - The celebratory breakfast location is being planned as several options are being considered. If the community garden has begun, the planting for Arbor Day will take place at that location.
- **Community Garden** – The Township is still waiting on the result of the state grant. It has been confirmed that irrigation exists on the property. Discussed were layout, parking, fencing, and trees. The committee will begin to obtain proposals from needed vendors.
- **Beautification and The Memorial Day Parade** – The committee will participate and support both events in 2014 taking place on May 17th and May 18th.

New Business

- A hazardous tree survey was discussed.
- The committee will become involved in the upkeep of the Veterans Memorial Garden located in the front of town center.
