Marlboro is very fortunate to have volunteers who give of their time and help to keep Marlboro the wonderful place it is. I have, from time to time, highlighted different committees and their impact on our community.

This week, I am spotlighting the Marlboro Alliance for the Prevention of Drug Abuse. The Alliance's mission is as a catalyst within our community to raise public awareness about substance abuse issues.

Many do not know where to turn for information, advice and guidance about how to

talk to your teen and what to do if you suspect a family member may have a drug issue. The Alliance is that resource.

The Alliance is one of the few places in the Township where representatives from the k-8 and high schools, Township Officials, police, parents, and residents come together to discuss the issues concerning our youth. Topics include, but are not limited to, drugs, alcohol, distracted driving, stress, and other concerns affecting our school children and members of the community.

The Alliance sponsors parent forums, trainings, teen nights and more. On February 7 at

7pm, Alliance will hold a free Narcan training. The training is open to anyone who wants to be prepared in case they are present at an heroin/opioid overdose. All participants receive a free Narcan kit and will be fully trained in its use.

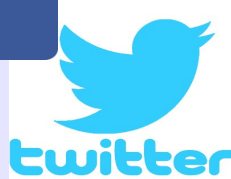
