Dear Registered Voter,

Tuesday, November 5, 2024 is New Jersey's General Election. Voter Registration deadline is October 15th. Complete a new registration for the general election or make changes to existing voter registration status. Voter registration link:

Early Voting - Early Voting allows registered voters to vote in person on a voting machine prior to the November 5th General Election. Early voting begins Saturday, October 26th to Sunday, November 3rd. Hours for early voting will be Monday-Saturday, 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Link for early voting locations:

Vote at Your Polling Location on Election Day – Polls are open from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday, November 5, 2024. Sample ballot mailing begins October 23rd, which includes your polling location. Link to polling locations:

Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballots – VBM mailing commences September 21st only to registered voters who requested one. See below the ways for returning VBM ballots. VBM ballots ARE NOT ACCEPTED at a polling locations or the Municipal Clerk's office.

- Ballot - mailed via U.S. mail (postmarked 8 p.m. on November 5th).
- Ballot – deliver to any Monmouth County ballot box by 8 p.m. on November 5th. Marlboro's ballot box is located in the municipal parking lot - 1979 Township Drive. [Click HERE for other Monmouth County Ballot Box locations.](#)
- Ballot – hand delivered to the Monmouth County Board of Elections located at 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold by 8 p.m. on November 5th, General Election.
- Deadline to apply for a Mail-In Ballot by Mail for General Election October 29, 2024. If you missed the deadline to apply, then you or a designated messenger may deliver the application to the County Clerk of Elections Office, 300 Halls Mill Road by 3 p.m. Monday, November 4, 2024.
- If a district worker tells you that you are not eligible to vote during the General Election, simply request and complete a provisional ballot.
