Tuesday, June 4, 2024 is New Jersey's Primary Election. May 14th is the deadline for Voter Registration. Complete a new registration for the primary election or change voter registration status (address change, name change, political party affiliation, etc. Voter registration link:

Early Voting - Early Voting allows registered voters to vote in person on a voting machine prior to the June 4th Primary Election. Early voting begins Wednesday, May 29th to Sunday, June 2nd. Hours for May 29th through June 1st, 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. June 2nd is 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Link for early voting locations:

Vote at Your Polling Location on Election Day – Polls are open from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. May 22nd begins sample ballot mailing and shows your polling location. Link to polling locations: https://voter.svrs.nj.gov/polling-place-search.

*NOTE: If you missed the May 14th voter registration deadline for changing political party affiliation, you may change party affiliation at your polling location on June 4th – Primary Election.

Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballots – April 20th begins VBM ballots mailing to registered voters who requested one. See below the ways for returning VBM ballots. VBM ballots ARE NOT ACCEPTED at a polling location.

- ➤ Ballot mailed via U.S. mail (postmarked by 8 p.m. on June 4).
- ➤ Ballot placed in any Monmouth County secure Ballot Drop Box by 8 p.m. on June 4th. Marlboro's Drop Box is in the Municipal parking lot located at 1979 Township Drive. <u>Click HERE for other Monmouth County Drop Box locations</u>.
- ➤ Ballot hand delivered to the Monmouth County Board of Elections located at 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold by 8 p.m. on June 4th, Primary Election.
- ➤ Vote by Mail applications: May 28, 2024 is the deadline for mailing a Vote by Mail application. If you missed the deadline to apply, then you, or a designated messenger may bring the application to the County Clerk of Elections Office, 300 Halls Mill Road and only till 3 p.m. Monday, June 3, 2024.
- If a district worker tells you that you are not eligible to vote during the Primary Election, simply request and complete a provisional ballot.
