

Bulk Pickup is scheduled by zone and there is no collection the week following Mother's Day. Please adhere to the schedule so that our streets remain clear and safe for children to play. Bulk Pickup dates, your street's zone and more can be found in the Recycling calendar mailed to your home and posted on the Township Website.

YES

- All items must be curbside by 7am of your first scheduled pickup day
- Once DPW collects they do not return
- Separate metal objects
- Remove doors from large appliances (they may be collected separately)
- Containers/drums must be empty and open
- Metal/wood swing sets must be disassembled and concrete footings removed.
- Remove or hammer down nails

BASKETBALL HOOPS

Recycling? Take apart and remove sand/water from the base.

NOT recycling? Move well away from the street so workers and scavengers know it is not bulk.

- Bulk items accepted at Recycling Center all year with free, online permit.
- Electrical (computer, TV electronics) accepted at recycling center free, no permit needed throughout year.

NO

- No TVs, electronics or computers
- No treated lumber
- No closed containers/drums
- No tires
- No dirt
- No tree stumps
- No batteries
- No bricks, rocks, slate or stones
- No leaves, branches or brush
- No liquids
- No hazardous waste
- No concrete or concrete filled objects
- No containers weighing over 300lbs
- No excessive construction debris
- No combining bulk items with neighbors
