P.B. 1139-16 SAM VERA RESTAURANT – PUBLIC HEARING – MINOR SITE PLAN

Mr. Herbert, Esq. noted that the affidavit pf publication and notice to adjoining property owners have been reviewed and are in order, therefore, the Board has the jurisdiction to hear this matter.

Dante Alfieri, Esq. represented the applicant. The 0.9 acre site contains 120 feet of frontage along Route 520 abutting the Osprey Court right-of-way to the east within the C-2 zone, block 207 Lot 21. Currently the property contains a restaurant, consisting of a 2 story building with associated walks, and a paved parking area for 64 vehicles to the rear of the building.

Robert Kee, P.E. testified on behalf of the applicant. Entered into evidence were the following exhibits:

- A-1 Colored pictures of the site dated July 6, 2016
- A-2 Architectural rendering of the deck dated April 16, 2016
- A-3 Site plan dated March 13, 2016

Mr. Kee stated that the applicant is proposing to construct a 480 s.f. (16' x 30') covered deck along the west side of the existing restaurant. The deck will be used as an area for people to smoke and there will be no additional dining seats in this area. A permanent roof made of metal is being proposed, but the deck area will not be enclosed. There will only be one tree removed and new trees will be planted in its place. No additional site improvements are proposed with this application.

Ms. Neumann, P.E., P.P. reviewed her report with the Board and answered questions.

P.B. 1141-16 REVIEW & RECOMMENDATION – FIREHOUSE SIGN

Ms. Neumann, P.E., P.P. discussed this application with the Board. She stated that Dean Staknys, P.E. Assistant Township Engineer reviewed this application.

The firehouse is located at 5 North Main Street, within the C-1 zone, Block 223 Lots 4 & 5. They are proposing to install a 5' x 8' electronic sign in the same location as the existing sign. The applicant will be responsible for the securing of all necessary construction permits,

The Board has no specific concerns with this application.
