MARLBORO TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING

October 21, 2021

The Marlboro Township Council held its regularly scheduled meeting on October 21, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. at the Marlboro Municipal Complex located at 1979 Township Drive, Marlboro, New Jersey.

Council President Cantor opened the meeting and announced that pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this regularly scheduled meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro was sent to the Asbury Park Press, the Star Ledger, News Transcript and the Board of Education Office on October 18, 2021; published in the Asbury Park Press on July 20, 2021; posted on the Bulletin Board of the Municipal Building; filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk and placed on the Township website and Channel 77.

The Municipal Clerk called the Roll.

Councilwoman Mazzola moved that the Council meeting minutes of October 7, 2021 be approved. This was seconded by Councilwoman Marder, and passed on a roll call vote of 4 - 0 in favor. Councilman Scalea abstained.

RESOLUTION #2021-314

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RELEASE OF PERFORMANCE GUARANTEES FOR THE SITE IMPROVEMENTS AT CAMELOT WEST AT MARLBORO LLC, BLOCK 150, LOTS 2, 3, AND 4, LOCATED AT TENNENT ROAD, MORGANVILLE NJ 07751

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-53, the Township of Marlboro has received a request from Liza A. Glazner, Kaplan Companies, for the release of the Township held Performance Guarantees in the form of a Bond and Letter of Credit for the Phase I and Phase II site improvements on the Site known as "Camelot West" (the "Site"), property known as Block 150, Lots 2, 3, and 4, on the Official Tax Maps of the Township of Marlboro, Monmouth County, State of New Jersey, posted by Camelot West at Marlboro, LLC (the "Developer"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Marlboro have received and reviewed the Township Engineer's report dated July 13, 2021, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid report recommends that the current Bond and Letter of Credit amounts being held by the Township be released in their entirety; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council desires to release the performance guarantee Bond and Letter of Credit amounts in their entirety in accordance with the recommendation of the Township Engineer's report dated July 13, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the performance guarantees in the form of a Bond and Letter of Credit posted by the Developer, Camelot West at Marlboro, LLC, for the Phase I site improvements on the site known as Camelot West located on property known as Block 150, Lot 2, 3, and 4, Township of Marlboro, New Jersey, shall be released as follows:

- Phase I Bond (First Indemnity of America Insurance Company, Bond No. FP0023323), in the original amount of \$886,713.00, present amount of \$267,221.76, shall be released in its entirety
- Phase I Letter of Credit (Provident Bank, No. 8050002423) in the original amount of

\$98,523.67 (excludes accrued interest), and present amount of \$29,691.31 (excludes accrued interest), shall be released in its entirety

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the performance guarantees in the form of a Bond and Letter of Credit posted by the Developer, Camelot West at Marlboro, LLC, for the Phase II site improvements on the site known as Camelot West located on property known as Block 150, Lot 2, 3, and 4, Township of Marlboro, New Jersey, shall be released as follows:

- Phase II Bond (First Indemnity of America Insurance Company, Bond No. FP0023324), in the original amount of \$275,538.16, present amount of \$138,351.46, shall be released in its entirety
- 2. Phase II Letter of Credit (Provident Bank, No. 8050002424) in the original amount of \$30,615.35 (excludes accrued interest), and present amount of \$15,372.38 (excludes accrued interest), shall be released in its entirety

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above releases shall be subject to the posting of any and all outstanding review and/or inspections fee charges to the time of the performance guarantee release, the posting of a two (2) year fifteen percent (15%) maintenance bond in the amount of \$147,785.50 for Phase I and \$45,923.03 for Phase II (overall total \$193,708.53).

RESOLUTION #2021-312

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF AN OPEN PUBLIC RECORDS SEARCH SYSTEM - RECORDS INFORMATION (OPRS-RIM) MANAGEMENT SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

WHEREAS, under the New Jersey Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, <u>et seq</u>., local units, such as the County of Monmouth and the Township of Marlboro, may enter into shared services agreements with each other, provided that each local unit adopts a resolution authorizing the shared services agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monmouth has entered into an agreement with Sunrise Systems, Inc. ("Sunrise"), whereby the County is licensed to access and use Sunrise's web-based system known as the Open Public Records Search System - Records Information Management ("OPRS-RIM"); and

WHEREAS, under the terms of its agreement with Sunrise, the County of Monmouth may operate an OPRS-RIM system for itself and sublicense the use of OPRS-RIM to municipalities within Monmouth County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monmouth, has offered to enter into a Shared Services agreement with the Township of Marlboro, whereby the Township will be authorized as a sublicensee to access and use the Monmouth County OPRS-RIM (the "Shared Services Agreement with Monmouth County"); and

WHEREAS, the OPRS-RIM provides for the Inventory Management, Retention Management, and Disposition Management of official records and includes an imaging module that permits the scanning of paper records into TIFF images, which may be stored long-term, searched and retrieved electronically; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of Marlboro Township believes that it is in the best interests of the Township for it to enter into the Shared Services Agreement with Monmouth County for the purposes described hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk be and are hereby authorized to enter into an OPRS-RIM Shared Services Agreement with Monmouth County, in an amount not to exceed \$3,300 in a form substantially similar to that attached hereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds in the amount of \$3,300 are available for the aforesaid contract from Current Account 0-201-200-20281.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4(b), a copy of the OPRS-RIM Shared Services Agreement with Monmouth County shall be filed with the Division of Local Government Affairs in the Department of Community Services for informational purposes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the OPRS-RIM Shared Services Agreement with Monmouth County shall be on file in the Municipal Clerk's Office; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be provided to each of the following:

RESOLUTION #2021-313

AUTHORIZING APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND EXECUTE A GRANT CONTRACT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FISCAL YEAR 2022 LOCAL FREIGHT IMPACT FUND

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A DEVELOPER'S AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN BROOKSTONE AT CASOLA FARM LLC AND THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF SIX SINGLE FAMILY LOTS AND ONE BASIN/OPEN SPACE LOT

WHEREAS, Brookstone at Casola Farm LLC (the "Developer") is the developer of certain real property known as Block 214, Lots 1 & 2 in the Township of Marlboro, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Developer made an application to the Marlboro Township Planning Board ("Planning Board") for Preliminary and Final Major Subdivision and Site Plan Approval Application No. PB-1195-19 to remove all existing site improvements and subdivide the Property into seven (7) new lots, six (6) for residential development and one (1) open space/stormwater management lot of 3 acres, as outlined in Resolution No. PB-1195-19 granting Preliminary and Final Major Subdivision Approval adopted on May 20, 2020 and memorialized on June 3, 2020 (hereinafter the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the approved Subdivision and Site Plan calls for certain improvements, and the Developer has agreed to construct those improvements, as shown on the Approved Plan and records before the Planning Board, all of which were made part of a Developer's Agreement, attached hereto as Attachment A; and WHEREAS, the Township Attorney has reviewed the attached agreements; and

WHEREAS, after analysis and review, the Township has determined it is in its best interest to enter into the Developer's Agreement in a form substantially similar to the attached agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.
- 2. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute the Developer's Agreement with Brookstone at Casola Farm LLC, for the purpose of memorializing the obligations and commitments of Casola Farm LLC, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
