MARLBORO TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING

October 19, 2023

The Marlboro Township Council held its regularly scheduled meeting on October 19, 2023 at 7:00 P.M. at the Marlboro Township Municipal Complex located at 1979 Township Drive, Marlboro, New Jersey.

The Council President requested a moment of silence for the people of Israel and Palestine.

Council President Qazi opened the meeting and announced that pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this regularly scheduled meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro was sent to the Asbury Park Press, the Star Ledger and the Board of Education Office on October 17, 2023; published in the Asbury Park Press on November 16, 2022; posted on the Bulletin Board of the Municipal Building; filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk and placed on the Township website and Channel 77.

The Municipal Clerk called the Roll.

PRESENT: Council Vice President DiNuzzo, Councilman Milman, Councilman Scalea and Council President Qazi. Councilwoman Marder was absent.

Citizen's Voice:

Daniel Matarese of 485 Texas Road wants to ensure that all business within the Township are properly licenses and have completed all required permits and inspections.

Lisa Pereira of 53 Dowing Lane, Jackson, New Jersey had questions regarding the state pension process.

Frank Festa of 1727 Ramapo Way, Scotch Plains, New Jersey said that he has not received engineering approval to proceed with building on his commercial property.

Sarah Samy of 5 Dickson Road is a student at Brookdale Community College and inquired about the Improvements to Ryan Road agenda item.

Jason Rabkin of 85 Station Road a student at Brookdale Community College had questions regarding proposed road construction on Station Road. <u>Council Speaks Out</u>: Councilman Milman expressed concerns regarding the Israel and Palestine conflict. Council Vice President DiNuzzo mentioned praying for peace in Israel and Palestine. Council President Qazi also stated this is a difficult time and wished for peace. The Council President provided updates for both police and public works departments.

Councilman Scalea moved that the Council meeting minutes of September 14, 2023 be approved. This was seconded by Council Vice President DiNuzzo, and passed on a roll call vote of 4 - 0 in favor. Councilwoman Marder was absent.

WHEREAS, the Township of Marlboro as part of its 2022 capital program (2022-060-06) authorized various road and drainage improvements to Ryan Road("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Township was awarded a grant in the amount of \$251,900.00 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) for the project; and

WHEREAS, the HINDU AMERICAN TEMPLE AND CULTURAL CENTER ("Hindu Temple"), has applied for a permit to host a fireworks display as part of their annual carnival event on property owned by the HINDU TEMPLE within the Township of Marlboro on October 2, 2023, such fireworks display to be undertaken by the HINDU TEMPLE's operator, Serpico Pyrotechnics, LLC, upon satisfaction of the conditions set forth in $\underline{N.J.S.A}$. 21:3-1, <u>et seq</u>. and in accordance with all applicable New Jersey Administrative Code regulations promulgated in accordance therewith, as amended from time to time.
