Applicant seeks to expand the size of his medical office to incorporate continuous video electroencephalography
EEG) Monitoring for patients age 5 and over for a period of 12-96 hours where a maximum of 8 patients are
continuously monitored. The EEG Monitoring would be less costly for patient than acute care provided in
nospital facilities. During the period that the patient is in the continuous video EEG monitoring unit, he/she
will stay in a private room that is ADA accessible and modeled to be close to a central monitoring station
where the EEG technologists on duty will be monitoring the video EEG telemetry screens, observing for any
sudden clinical changes in a patient's behavior (see proposed construction plans). The patients will always be
attended to by the EEG technologists preforming the diagnostic studies and by non-clinical staff members who as
in helping patients maintain their comfort during the prolonged study.
